Please read prior to booking

- ★ All field based¹ projects are limited to TWO classes and will be conducted over two days (please book two days). The first day includes one presentation per class, and the second day includes a field project for both classes combined. The field project will be completed by 12pm. The lead teacher should book for both classes and forward automated emails to collaborating teacher. If booking for more than two classes, please treat them as separate bookings.
 - The field portion of the projects will include many activities, some of which will have to be lead by teachers and volunteers with limited help from the Digital Bus staff.
- ★ All school based² projects are limited to ONE class per day. All activities will be completed at the school—including a classroom presentation followed by two/three rotations to the Digital Bus for activities (up to 8 students per rotation). The lead teacher may book for all classes and forward automated emails to collaborating teachers. Please book one day per class.
 - A certified adult must be present in the bus with the Digital Bus staff. During the bus rotations, other students will remain in the classroom with their teacher.
