July 5,6,7,10&11, 2006**

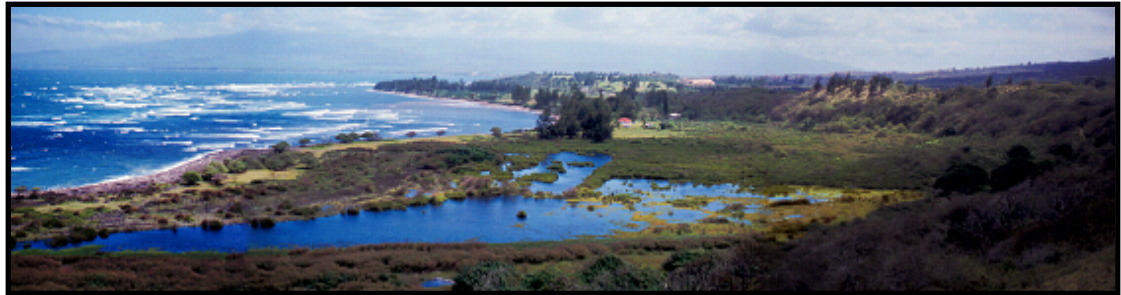
Coastal Waihe'e Field Studies using GPS & Digital Tools

Teachers will learn about the Waihe'e Reserve, conducting two days of field studies there. They will learn to use technology that will facilitate interdisciplinary, standards-based investigations of these four zones: The Coastal Strand, The Wetlands, The Riparian Environment, and The Dunes. Teachers will plan a unit on one of these four zones to implement during the school year with students, incorporating field studies.
