In-Person Project FAQs

How do the in-person projects work, in one sentence please?

A Digital Bus project will consist of a guest speaking session in your classroom, followed by either student rotations into The Digital Bus (if selecting a campus based project), or a field trip (if selecting a field based project).

How much do the programs cost?

All projects are entirely free! We will also cover all school bus fees.

Who is allowed to participate?

The projects are available to all DOE school in Maui.

What grade levels are the projects for?

We have projects available for all grades from Kindergarten to 12th grade..

What are the topics of project?

We offer a variety of topic, but most focus on place based learning in environmental science, biology, and ecology.

Availability of projects will vary by year, please email us for current list.

How do I schedule a project?

On our quarterly newsletters, we include a link to our sign up form. Please sign up on our website. You can also find the link to the scheduling form on our website.

What are the requirements for participating teachers?

Teachers will be required to prep their students before the project, create a schedule for Digital Bus rotations, and work with The Digital Bus staff to schedule busses and field trips (if applicable). Teacher will also be asked to fill out a survey after completion of the project.

How long do the projects take?

This depends on the project. Campus projects are completed within 2 to 3 hours per class. Field projects will take 2 days per class.

Where are the field trips?

This depends on the project. Our most common locations are Kealia Pond, Kanaha Pond, Waihee Coastal Refuge, Kipuka Olowalu, The Maui Ocean Center.

Do I need supplies for students to complete any of the activities?

No, we will provide everything for the students. For the field trips, student are expected to bring lunches.

I'm not interested in an entire project, but would love The Digital Bus to be a station at our existing field trip. Can you do this?

Will there be more topics in the future?
