## The Maui Digital Bus <br> Virtual / Hybrid Project Details

## OVERVIEW

Our virtual projects will now be primarily available as hybrid learning projects! Originally designed due to Covid, they are a combination of self directed activities, classroom discussions, research projects, Digital Bus produced videos, and video chats with the Digital Bus. The hybrid version of the project adds in-person Q\&A sessions, a Digital Bus visit, and a field trip! Projects are available for a range of grade levels, approximately kindergarten through 8th.

When directly scheduling a project, teachers and students will receive the following:

- A hard copy of the project for each student.
- An introduction meet-and-greet with the Digital Bus staff (virtual or in-person).
- Optional video or in-person meet-ups following each project module.
- A Digital Bus visit and/or a field trip.
- A conclusion session with the Digital Bus staff.


## TIMELINE of PROJECT

1. Third through eighth grade projects begin with a "meet-and-greet" chat with the Digital Bus staff and the entire class.
2. Students will then complete each project module one at a time.
3. Upon completion of each module, teachers will lead a discussion with their class going over answers and comments.
4. Teachers have the option to schedule a live video chat or in-person session with the Digital Bus staff upon completing each module.
5. Students will move onto the next assigned module.
6. Students will participate in the optional field trip.
7. Projects will end with a "Conclusion" video chat or in-person session with the Digital Bus staff and the entire class.

Duration of project completion is at the teacher's discretion. Completion of an entire project can be as quickly as two months or last the entire year. Teachers are encouraged to pace the project or change its order to reflect their needs and the rhythm of their students.
